Enthusiasm for science subjects and an eagerness to share that enthusiasm with learners of all ages. Demonstrated presentation and group management skills. Strong customer service, interpersonal, active listening, and public speaking skills. 18+ years of age.

Preferred: Undergraduate coursework in an area of science.
