The **Trades Helper** position is primarily responsible for assisting the Skilled Trades and for performing semi-skilled work associated with basic trades operations. This position is viewed as an apprentice.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Responsible for bringing necessary supplies to the job site
- Assists in unloading trucks, etc.
- Helps set up ladders, scaffolding and other necessary equipment
- Performs miscellaneous duties for various Skilled Trades as necessary during a job
- Assist in surface preparation, plastering and repair of holes
- Assist in material application
- Assist in furniture covering and masking
- Assist with installation, maintenance, and repair of various window treatments
- Must be aware of proper procedures to use when encountering suspected asbestos containing material to avoid personal exposure, contamination of job site and exposure of facility occupants to asbestos
- Maintains a clean working environment and cleans up job site after work is completed
- Other duties as assigned

Requirements:

- On the job training in Skilled and Semi-Skilled trades, as required of an apprentice
- Demonstrated ability to operate tools and equipment safely
- Ability to prepare surfaces for materials applications
- Ability to learn and achieve journeyman apprentice level in one of the Skilled Trades
- Ability to understand technical direction
- Valid Michigan driver's license with satisfactory driving record

Shift is Monday – Friday 7:30 am – 4:00 pm; pay rate is \$17.67 per hour.
